

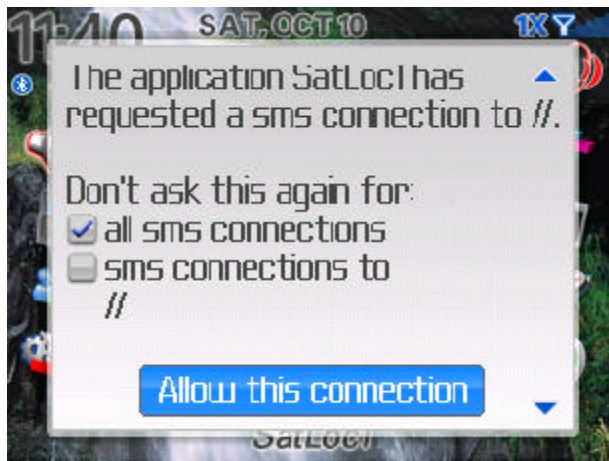
# Installing SatTracx application in BlackBerry Devices

**Before installing SatTracx application in your device follow below steps**

1. Go to Options -> Security Options -> Firewall.  
→Its status will be disabled so enable it.  
→Select Edit default permissions its status will be custom then change to allow.

**After following the above steps install SatTracx application in Blackberry device**

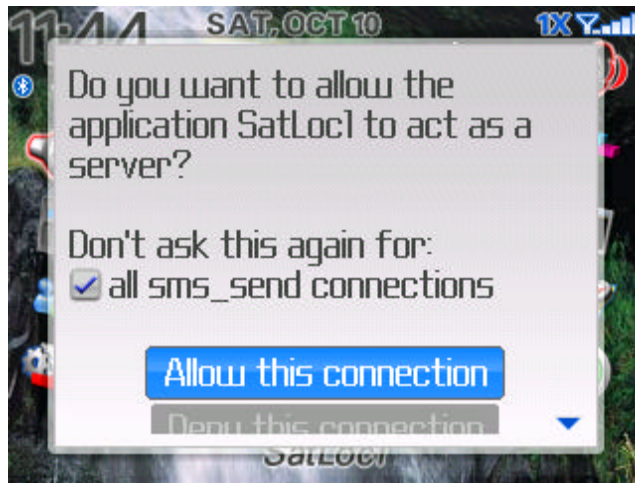
1. Connect your Blackberry device with a Data Cable.
2. Start Blackberry Desktop Manager, subsequently, select Blackberry Application Loader.  
**Note:** If Blackberry Desktop Manger is not available, you need to install it first on the computer  
After starting application loader, click on, **Add** to load the SatTracx Application on to your device.
3. To load the application, browse the downloaded folder which contains **SatTracx.alx** and **SatTracx.cod** file. **Note:** After downloading the SatTracx application zip file, kindly extract that zip folder into your computer desktop
4. Select **SatTracx.alx** file and install into your mobile.
5. The application will appear with SatGuide icon in the menu list with the name SatTracx .
6. The application will ask for confirmation 3 times.  
**Note:** Below confirmation messages shown based on device.
7. You will be asked for the confirmation, check all sms connections and click Allow this connection button as shown below.



8. Then you will be asked for the all sms\_receive confirmation, select all sms\_receive connections and click Allow this connection button.



9. Then there is a final confirmation, select all sms\_send connections, and click Allow this connection button.



10. In all confirmations tick all the check box and then click the “**Allow this Connection**” button. **Dont forget to tick the “Dont ask again checkbox” to avoid confirmation.**
11. Now the application has been started in the background.
12. For Blackberry Mobile devices to have an uninterpreted service please Set the **SMS Format to Text Mode**, Please follow the following steps to set the SMS format.

Go to **Main Menu ? Options ? SMS ? Data Coding** You will find options **7bit / UCS2**. Please Select **7bit**.
